### ON-LINE REGISTRATION:

- The most efficient way to sign up for a training or an event is to use our new on-line registration offered through our website.
- Find the complete Events Calendar and registration info under the Take Action tab on the website.
- Registration for most events opens on the Monday approximately 60 days prior to event date.
- Troops will be placed in the event beginning on the Wednesday following registration opening. A confirmation will be e-mailed to you (mailed upon request) after you are placed in the event. A few weeks prior to the event, event details will be e-mailed to you (mailed upon request).
- Registrations will also be accepted in person, by mail, email or fax through the Council Office (those registering via e-mail should phone in credit card payment). Payment will be collected at the time of registration to either confirm space or to be added to the waitlist.

### EXCITING EVENTS:
