

## Cookie Credits Explained

All troops receive troop profits from the cookie sale. In addition, girls/troops can receive. . .

1. **Individual Cookie Credits (ICC):** A girl can earn \$1 credit for every box of cookies sold to help pay for a National or Council sponsored destination she was selected for. ICC may also be used when attending “Get Aways”. Visit [www.studio2b.org/escape/destinations](http://www.studio2b.org/escape/destinations) for more information on National destinations and Get Aways.
2. **Troop Trip Cookie Credits (TTCC):** Troops can earn a \$1 credit for every box sold as a troop to help fund an approved trip. TTCC is approved through an application process a year in advance. Contact Tasha Nichols for more information on this program.
3. **Encampment Troop Cookie Credits (ETCC):** Troops attending Encampment will earn credit for every box sold as a troop to help pay for Encampment. ETCC is based on the number of boxes sold and calculated as follows:
  - 10 cents per box for troops on-road system
  - 15 cents per box for troops off-road system
4. **Camp Cookie Credits (CCC):** Girls can earn CCC to help pay their way to camp. CC is based on the number of boxes sold and calculated as follows:
  - 15 cents credit per box at any council operated day camp
  - 30 cents credit per box at resident camp
  - 400 boxes equal a free session at day camp (or 3 day Girl Scout Camp program)
  - 500 boxes equal a free session at Camp Kenai Lake, Camp Featherwinds, and Camp Wilderness Adventure
  - 600 boxes equals a free session (up to one week in length) at Camp Togowoods

**Please Note:** Cookie credits can only be used once: for the approved trip/destination or by an individual girl for camp. Cookie credits may not be transferred from one girl to another. Cookie credits have no cash value and are redeemable only during the current Girl Scout membership year. Troops or individual girls receiving TTCC or ICC will not receive incentives.
