All activities are to be completed during the current membership year (Oct.1-Sept 30). Troops must be registered in order to participate. Each activity counts toward one requirement. A minimum of 100 points is required. Shaded requirements are mandatory.

1	REGISTRATION (30 points max)	<i>Points</i>
a.	The troop re-registered by Sept. 30, all registration information correct and complete (10 points)	
b.	New, never registered troop registered before their third meeting. (10 points)	
c.	Registered additional adults to help the troop (5 points)	
d.	All leaders & assistant leaders (position 01 & 02) are registered and have turned in their Leader/Co-leader Agreement Forms (5 points) MANDATORY	

2	GIRL MEMBERSHIP (25 points max)	<i>Points</i>
a.	Troop registers as many girls in September as were active in June. (10 points)	
b.	If a NEW TROOP, by November 30 have the following number of girls registered: Daisy (5), Brownie (6), Junior (6), Cadette (5), Senior (5), Ambassador (5). (10 points)	
c.	Troop registers additional girls after Jan.1. (5 points)	

3	ADULT TRAINING/MEETINGS (max 25 points)	<i>Points</i>
a.	Troop has an adult certified in First Aid/CPR (5 points)	
b.	Leader attended Leader Training. (10 points)	
c.	Troop leader or designated representative attended at least 50% of service unit leader meetings. (10 points) MANDATORY	

4	FAMILY GIVING (10 Points)	<i>Points</i>
	At least 25% of troop parents made a gift to Family Giving Program	

5	GIRL RECRUITMENT (10 Points)	<i>Points</i>
	75% of active troop members took part in a meeting or event to help recruit additional Girl Scouts	

6	PRODUCT SALES (20 Points max)	<i>Points</i>
a.	Participated in cookie sale (10 points) MANDATORY	
b.	Participated in Fall Product Sale (10 points)	

7	BRIDGING (10 points)	<i>Points</i>
	Troop took part in two activities with sister troop of a different level which leads to a bridging patch.	

8	GIRL SCOUT VISIBILITY (10 points)	<i>Points</i>
	75 % of active troop members took part in activities which increased Girl Scout visibility in their community (flag ceremony for civic group, parade, uniform day, etc.)	

9	COUNCIL PATCHES (10 points)	<i>Points</i>
	Completed one council patch program other than Super Troop. (see Council Patches booklet)	

10	SERVICE (15 points max)	<i>Points</i>
	Troop did service projects with 75% of active troop members participating. (5 points each project) Project _____	

11	SPECIAL EVENTS (15 points Max)	<i>Points</i>
	75% of active registered troop members took part in activities observing a special Girl Scout day (Juliette Low's Birthday, World Thinking Day, Girl Scout Week) or Council Event. (5 points each event) Events: _____	

12	OUTDOOR PROGRAM (30 points max)	<i>Points</i>
	Troop participated in outdoor activities. May include outdoor meeting, cookout, all day outing, or campout. (10 points for each activity).	

13	SUMMER ACTIVITIES (5 points)	<i>Points</i>
	50% of active registered troop members participated in a summer troop activity.	

14	GIRL SCOUT PROGRAM (10 points)	<i>Points</i>
a.	Each Daisy participated in the Petal Program or a Journey.	
b.	Each Brownie or Junior earned one badge or Try-It or patch from a Journey for their age level.	
c.	Each Cadette, Senior or Ambassador completed one interest project, one focus book, one Journey, or one requirement toward the Silver or Gold Award
