- I agree that all money collected must be given to my Girl Scout’s Troop by the Council-set deadlines or any earned incentive items will be withheld until GSAK receives the outstanding balance.
- If my account is delinquent and not brought current prior to the expiration of ticketed or time-sensitive recognition items, GSAK will not be obligated to reissue, replace, substitute, or refund the value of said recognitions. Families with delinquent accounts will be unable to participate in the any other GSAK product program or apply for Camp Scholarships until the debt has been paid.
- GSAK reserves the right to seek the services of a collection agency and/or pursue legal action for delinquent accounts.
- GSAK reserves the right to substitute recognition items of equal or greater value without notice.
- Any Girl Scout found to be selling before the official start dates, or through prohibited methods, will not receive recognition items or Fall Product Camp Credits.
- Unsold product cannot be returned to, or exchanged, at council office.
- Adults serve in a supporting role for girls **and should not assume sole responsibility for sales**. Any sales made not involving the listed Girl Scout will not be counted toward rewards.
- Girls or their families may engage in online selling through the M2 system and/or by providing the girl M2 link on individual/family social media/web pages. **For the safety of the girls, sales may not be cultivated through group or public social media/web pages.** Payment for sales can only be taken in person or through the M2 online system.
- Unless otherwise indicated by a written note attached to this form, my daughter has full parental permission to participate in the online portion of this program under the supervision of myself, GSAK troop and service unit volunteers, and GSAK staff.
