1	Do you have a fever or above-normal temperature (about 100F)?												
2	Have you taken fever reducers in the past 72 hours?												
3	Have you been experiencing shortness of breath or having trouble breathing?												
4	In the past 72 hours, have you had a dry cough, runny nose or sore throat?												
5	Have you recently lost or had a reduction in your sense of smell or taste?												
6	In the past 72 hours, have you had any other flu-like symptoms, such as stomach upset, headache, muscle pain or fatigue?												
7	In the past 72 hours, have you had chills or repeated shaking with chills?												
8	Have you been tested COVID-19? If yes, what date was the test and what was the result (positive, negative, awaiting result)												
9	In the past 14 days, have you been in contact with someone who has a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19 or respiratory illness (including at school)?												
10	In the past 14 days have you traveled outside Alaska (either internationally or in the US)?												

Prior to *each* in-person meeting, all participants (girls and adults) should be screened to ensure they are healthy, haven't experienced any COVID-19 symptoms in the previous 72 hours and haven't knowingly been in contact with someone who has COVID-19. If a participant answers "yes" to any of the pre-screening questions they should not attend in-person meetings until 72 hours after symptoms end without the use of medication. If a participant has been tested and is still awaiting results they should not attend in-person meetings. If a participant has traveled (questions 9-10) they should not attend in-person meetings for 14 days after returning. Leaders may use a written questionnaire or verbally ask questions and keep a written log of answers. Troops should keep a record of each participant's answers for each in-person meeting for 3 years.

These records do not have to be turned into the council unless requested by Girl Scout staff.
