Important Update – Cookie Season Extended to April 7

Based on feedback, the cookie surplus across the council, and the holiday on March 31, we will be extending cookie season by one week to Sunday, April 7.

What this means:

- In-Person Sales: Girls/troops have the option to continue to sell cookies in-person and host booths until Sunday, April 7.
- Digital Cookie: Girl delivered, direct ship, and cookies-in-hand via Digital Cookie will remain open until Sunday, April 7.
- Booth Locations: We are working to secure locations for April 6-7. Watch the booth sign up in eBudde for available sites.

Upcoming dates to know:

- April 9: The new deadline for rewards submission will be April 9. GEMS will also be counted through April 9.
- April 9: The last day to update eBudde will be April 9.
- April 12: The next ACH date will remain on April 12. Troops may request an extension if needed.

An email update will go out to caregivers tomorrow, March 28.



No Fault Cookie Check-Out

Beginning April 1, troops may check out cases of cookies to sell. Any full, un-open cases may be returned to the council cupboard. Returns must be made by the end of the day on April 9. Only cookies checked out in April may be returned.

Grab Bags

Beginning April 1, every troop who picks up 10 or more cases from the council cupboard will receive a mystery grab bag! Grab bag prizes range from stickers to troop activities with supplies to coupons to the council shop!

Cookie Swaps

Cookie swaps will still end on Friday, March 29.

Council Cookie Cupboard is Open

The council cookie cupboard is open seven days a week 9am to 5pm. If you are local to the cupboard, please place your order on eBudde. If you are in a rural area hoping to be re-stocked, please reach out to the council and we will place your order once we have arranged shipping.

The council cookie cupboard will be closed on April 3. It will re-open with normal hours on April 4.

Booths Available for Sign-up

As troops release booths, they immediately become available for sign-up to all troops. If your favorite location was taken in January, check again because it may be open now! Council is working to add additional booth opportunities for the weekend of April 6-7. Large chains which we sign a corporate agreement with or fill out other required paperwork will not be available for this additional booth weekend. This includes Fred Meyer, Carrs/Safeway, and military Commissary's.

Lowe's

Lowe's stores have announced that they will be closed on Sunday, March 31. All booths at Lowe's stores on Sunday, March 31, are cancelled. There are many booth locations still available for sign up. Council will be contacting troops impacted.
