Goal Getter
The Goal Getter phase continues through February! Girl Scouts can enter their goals and get started selling or continue taking orders online or in-person this month. If you set your goals and send at least 18 emails, you earn the Cookie Techie Patch.

Pending Cupboard Orders
Pending cupboard orders open! They will be filled in the order they are received as soon as cookies arrive in the cupboard. If we have a large demand of pending orders, we will secure a restock.

First ACH Payment is March 14th

On March 14, council will automatically withdraw the amount your troop owes from the troop bank account. The amount your troop owes is available on the “Sales Report” tab on eBudde.

Troop Site Setup
Digital Cookie Troop Site set up begins February 1. Troop sites may begin taking orders on February 1 as well. Remember, troop sites must be set up before you can use them to process credit cards at cookie booths.

Initial Order Rewards
Initial order rewards ship separately from cookies and may or may not arrive at the same time as cookies. Your service unit cookie manager will let you know when initial order rewards are ready to be picked up.

Troop Booths
Don't forget, any cookie booth secured by a troop must be entered into eBudde as a troop booth! This allows us to advertise your booth to the public, as well as ensures that your booth is covered by our insurance.
