#### If you cannot attend a cookie booth be sure to release the booth in eBudde. This

can be done right from the homepage and can be done up to the minute before the booth begins. The National Cookie Finder helps customers find cookie booths! If you are signed up for a booth it appears in the cookie finder. If you then do not attend the booth, customers may arrive expecting to be able to purchase cookies and then not be able to. If you release the booth in eBudde, it will be removed from the cookie finder automatically, and then customers will know to go elsewhere for a cookie booth at that time. There is no penalty for releasing a cookie booth.
