Cookie Program News


Releasing Cookie Booths
If you cannot attend a cookie booth be sure to release the booth in eBudde. This can be done right from the homepage and can be done up to the minute before the booth begins. The National Cookie Finder helps customers find cookie booths! If you are signed up for a booth it appears in the cookie finder. If you then do not attend the booth, customers may arrive expecting to be able to purchase cookies and then not be able to. If you release the booth in eBudde, it will be removed from the cookie finder automatically, and then customers will know to go elsewhere for a cookie booth at that time. There is no penalty for releasing a cookie booth.

Enter Troop Booths on eBudde
Don't forget, any cookie booth secured by a troop must be entered into eBudde as a troop booth! This allows us to advertise your booth to the public, as well as ensures that your booth is covered by our insurance.

S'more for the Freezer Incentive
Sell 15 boxes of direct ship cookies from Wednesday February 19-Thursday February 27 and be entered to win a special treat for your group at camp or a JUMBO Squishmallow! Don't forget to remind your customers the Girl Scout S'mores cookies will be gone after this cookie season so they should buy *s'more for the freezer* if that is their favorite cookie!

Pending Cupboard Orders
Pending cupboard orders open! They will be filled in the order they are received as soon as cookies arrive in the cupboard. If we have a large demand of pending orders, we will secure a restock.

First ACH Payment is March 14th
On March 14, we will automatically withdraw the amount your troop owes from the troop bank account. The amount your troop owes is available on the "Sales Report" tab on eBudde.
