Queue-it

Junior troops and above who wish to travel in 2025 or 2026 may opt out of cookie rewards for additional proceeds. Intent to travel paperwork and the rewards opt out form are due February 1.

This weekend is expected to be a high traffic weekend for Digital Cookie. To prevent too much traffic to the site at one time, GSUSA will be using Queue-it at peak times. Customers may experience wait times of 30 seconds to a minute when accessing a Girl Scouts site, only if national traffic to Digital Cookie has passed certain levels. This system was in place last year as well, and we did not have any reports of issues.

Cookie Booth sign-ups dates will be announced once most of our booth partners have confirmed dates and times with us. Right now, we are still waiting for many confirmations. We hope to give you more information soon.
