General Counselors

Full season dates: May 24-August 11 (\$415/week* + room and board)

Half season dates: May 24-July 1; July 4-August 11 (\$415/week* + room and board)

Work with a staff partner to plan and deliver outdoor activities to a group of 8-12 girls with whom you live and supervise. Create and lead original, age appropriate activities that totally engage your campers. Supervise all aspects of your campers' day including wake up, meals, rest hour, getting ready for bed and night time.

Wilderness Counselors

Full season dates: May 24-August 11 (\$435/week* + room and board)

Half season dates: May 24-July 1; July 4-August 11 (\$435/week* + room and board)

Work with a staff partner to plan and deliver outdoor activities to a group of 8-12 girls with whom you live and supervise. This will include leading groups on overnight or multiday canoeing and backpacking trips. When you aren't on trail with your group, create and lead original, age appropriate activities that totally engage your campers. Supervise all aspects of your campers' day including wake up, meals, rest hour, getting ready for bed and night time. Staff must have current Wilderness First Aid or Wilderness First Responder certification.

Waterfront/Boating Counselors

Full season dates: May 24-August 11 (\$435/week* + room and board)

Work with counselors to develop and implement the aquatics program from kayaking the lake's perimeter or canoe on a floating lunch to swimming in the lake. Help campers of all ages learn a progression of paddling skills in canoeing, kayaking and row-boating. Waterfront counselors are responsible for overseeing all aspects of the water including risk management, emergency procedures as well as supervising staff who help at the waterfront. Current lifeguard certification required. Canoeing, rowing and/ or kayaking experience is required. Must be at least 21 years old.

Art & Crafts Counselor

Full season dates: May 24-August 11 (\$415/week* + room and board)

Work with counselors to develop and implement the arts and crafts program from tie-dye to craft projects in nature. Help campers of all ages have a successful arts and crafts experience by demonstrating projects, letting girls be creative and encouraging artistic exploration. The Arts & Crafts Counselor is responsible for overseeing all aspects of the arts and crafts program including risk management, emergency procedures, cleanliness and supervision of staff and campers.

Climbing Wall Program Counselors

Full season dates: May 24-August 11 (\$435/week* + room and board)

Work with counselors to develop and implement the climbing wall program using a challenge by choice philosophy. Help campers of all ages learn teamwork and climbing through a progression of climbing activities. Climbing Wall Program Counselors are responsible for all aspects of the climbing program including risk management, emergency procedures, daily safety checks as well as supervising staff who help at the climbing tower. Certification or extensive experience in climbing, adventure programming, or challenge courses needed. Must be at least 21 years old.

Healthcare Program Counselor

Full season dates: May 24-August 11 (\$970/week* + room and board)

Half season dates: May 24-July 1; July 4-August 11 (\$970/week* + room and board)

Attend to the physical well-being and care of campers and staff. The Healthcare Program Counselor is responsible for dispensing camper medications, providing basic care for injuries and illnesses and informing camp staff and parents of health concerns as needed. In addition they are responsible for overseeing all aspects of health care including health screenings, communication with the clinic, risk management, sanitations and health standards. Current Alaska licensed RN, Nurse Practitioner, or LPN is required. Must be at least 21 years old.

Cooks

Full season dates: May 24-August 11 (\$500/week* + room and board)

Work to prepare delicious, wholesome meals and snacks that fuel the campers and staff for fun at camp. Cooks are responsible for a variety of health and safety procedures including dishwashing, sweeping, and mopping. Current ServSafe certification preferred.

* A travel stipend is included in the weekly pay listed above and is evenly split between each paycheck. Like all pay, taxes, social security, and Medicare are taken from travel stipends.
