NEW Annual Permission Form

We have simplified and combined several forms into one, easy to use, Annual Permission Form! This document should be completed girls and volunteers at your first troop meeting of the year. This form replaces the single/multi-use permission form, product program permission form, permission to treat form (except for international travel), and health history form. Parents/Guardians must complete both sides for their Girl Scout. Volunteers must complete only the health history portion. All forms should be kept with the troop leader and taken on any field trips or overnights. Check it out here.

Insurance Changes Starting October 1

Starting October 1, you will no longer need to purchase additional insurance for domestic overnights or Girl Scout activities that include non-members (day or overnight). Optional additional insurance that includes sickness coverage (Plan 3P), is available for \$0.70/person/day. International travelers will still be required to purchase additional insurance (Plan 3PI).


NEW Troop Mailing Addresses We're excited to share that we l

Spotlight: Troop 625, Mirror Lake Trail Restoration Troop 625 worked with Anchorage

Parks and Recreation and the Chugach Mountain Bike Riders to restore the Mirror Lake Single Track Mountain Bike Blue Bog Trail as they worked towards earning their Silver Award. Due to poor conditions the Single Track Mountain Bike Blue Bog Trail was infrequently used. To compensate for the muddy/boggy atmosphere the girls dug trenches to reroute water and brought in and spread 10 tons of gravel to address the issue. In addition to trail maintenance the troop built two technical trail challenges to enhance the trail and users experience. The first trail challenge is single width, 16-0" long. The second challenge is double wide, 24'-0" long.
